It was really amazing that the camp bosei has been succeeded in the relationship through judo with the teachers, the students and the families. I think it's difficult to make such a strong connection by just doing sports.

The camp bosei gathered people who like judo and judo friends and people who don't give up doing anything and try to improve themselves.

In the judo lessons of the camp, the intent feeling of the students who are from various countries toward judo were the same. It was no concern of nationality. And their earnest face were the same when they listened to the teacher's lecture and in randori. I was very happy to join the camp and be able at least to help them with Miller sensei and Martin as hosts.

My best memory is that I saw their true smile when I took pictures of them. It seemed really joyful smile from their heart. And I'm glad that experience through the camp changed the student's mind positively.
